As a standard of care, we have thorough disinfecting and sterilization procedures that are required of every employee as well as protocols for daily infection control in the waiting room and other common areas. Furthermore, we have a generous employee paid time off program that allows every employee to stay home from work when they're sick. In addition to our usual protocols you will notice an increased the amount of regular office cleaning which has always included daily disinfection. We are screening patients for fever or flu like symptoms and cancelling their visit until they seek care from their primary care physician.
